With the new KDEA arena, dressage classes will be held outside in the sand arena. Weather permitting, stadium will be on the grass, or may be moved to the sand arena (only if dressage classes are done by then). Warmup for dressage will be in the indoor arena.

Combined Tests (Dressage and Stadium). Cost: \$25.00 each. Horses must be at least 4 and the horse/rider combination must be the same in all phases. The dressage test must be ridden before you will be given permission to complete the jumping phase.

Class 17. Starter Division. Dressage: 2007 Walk Trot Test A (small arena). Stadium: Cross rails or ground poles, not to exceed 18”

Class 18. Beginner Novice Division. Dressage: 2006 Beginner Novice **Test B** (small arena). Stadium: 8-10 jumping efforts over a course of approx 350 to 400 meters at 300 meters per minute. Maximum height 2’3”

Class 19. Novice Division. Dressage: 2006 Novice **Test B** (small arena). Stadium: 8-12 jumping efforts over a course of approximately 400 meters at 300 meters per minute. Max height 2’11.

Class 20. Training Division. Dressage: 2006 Training **Test B** (small arena). Stadium: 10-12 jumping efforts over a course approximately 400-450 meters at 425 meters per minute. Maximum height 3’3”.

Jumper Classes: Cost: \$10.00 per horse/rider combination. Course will be 10-12 fences, including combinations. Clear round to win...if multiple clear horses, they will ride a jump off over a select number of fences already jumped. If no clear rounds, those with equal faults will ride the jump off for first place. Fastest time with least faults will win.

Class 21. 2 foot 6” Show Jumping Class

Class 22. 3 foot Show Jumping Class

Class #23 Call Your Score – This is a new class. Enter the dressage classes (#1 to #16) above that you wish to ride, and then declare which test(s) you want to Call Your Score. You state the score you think you will receive in that test. We will not show your declared score to the judge, and the person whose “guess” of their score is closest to the score they actually receive – is declared the winner. You don’t ride a separate test...your test that you’ve already entered will be used. The cost for this “class” is \$5.00, and you may enter more than one of your tests as “Call Your Score.” 50% of the entry fees collected will be split 50/50 for First and Second place in the “Call Your Score” class with the remaining entry fees going to the Education Committee for future activities. Come join the fun! We will post the Call Your Score scoreboard, and you can watch the class results during the show. Hopefully you will have the kind of ride you predicted...but we all know horses will be horses!
