Combined Tests (Dressage and Stadium). Cost: \$25.00 each. Horses must be at least 4 and the horse/rider combination must be the same in all phases. The dressage test must be ridden (successfully) before you will be given permission to complete the jumping phase.

Remember that all combined test dressage tests (except for Starter division), must be ridden from memory!

Class 17. Starter Division. Dressage: 2007 Intro (Walk Trot) **Test B** (small arena). Stadium: Cross rails or ground poles, not to exceed 18”

Class 18. Beginner Novice Division. Dressage: 2006 Beginner Novice **Test B** (small arena). Stadium: 8-10 jumping efforts over a course of approx 350 to 400 meters at 300 meters per minute. Maximum height 2’3”

Class 19. Novice Division. Dressage: 2006 Novice **Test B** (small arena). Stadium: 8-12 jumping efforts over a course of approximately 400 meters at 300 meters per minute. Max height 2’11.”

Class 20. Training Division. Dressage: 2006 Training **Test B** (small arena). Stadium: 10-12 jumping efforts over a course approximately 400-450 meters at 425 meters per minute. Maximum height 3’3”.

Jumper Classes: Cost: \$10.00 per horse/rider combination. Course will be 10-12 fences, including combinations. Clear round to win....if multiple clear horses, they will ride a jump off over a select number of fences already jumped. If no clear rounds, those with equal faults will ride the jump off for first place. Fastest time with least faults will win.

Class 21. 2’6” Show Jumping Class

Class 22. 2’9” Show Jumping Class

Class #23 Call Your Score– \$10.00. Enter whichever dressage test you want above, paying the class fee plus the \$10.00 Call Your Score Fee. Write down the score you think you’ll earn on the test, and whoever is closest to “calling their score” wins. 50% of the entry fees collected will be split 50/50 for First and Second place in the Call Your Score class with the remaining entry fees going to the Education Committee for future activities.
