After your ride, you will have the opportunity to talk to the judge, get exercises to help improve your test, then ride it (or parts of it) again or ride another test. You and the judge will decide how to best use your time! Remember that Dressage tests are dated 2023, Western Dressage tests are dated 2022, Eventing tests are dated 2022, and Working Equitation tests are dated 2023.
