Riders 14 and under may enter 2 classes with no fees (no entry \$\$, no admin fee) and may enter additional tests by paying the stated entry \$\$ and admin fee. You must be a member of KDEA to show, and your membership, along with required volunteer hours, make you eligible for KDEA year end awards.

Complete entries must be received by 4pm on the Entry Due Date. Complete entry includes a signed entry form **for each horse/rider combo**, payment of fees, and a negative Coggins dated within 12 months prior to the show. Final ride times will be available by Thursday prior to the show at www.kdea.org and will be emailed to each rider. Entries received after the Entry Due Date may be accepted if space is available.
